I am responding on behalf of Dordon Parish Council to your follow up questions from your letter dated 11 April 2023. The Parish Council's response is in italics.

Question 3 – Concerning the residents' Regulation 14 consultation responses, the Consultation Statement should contain a summary of the main issues and concerns raised by the persons consulted. I am told that Appendix C shows "how the parish council amended the DNP based on these responses". I cannot see this. Please could you provide further information?

The residents' comments were very largely supportive of the approach in the Pre-Submission Draft (see figure 1 page 11 of the Consultation Statement). The comments shown at Appendix C expand on this and show that they endorse the approach taken in the DNP. Nothing specifically was added based on the residents' comments because emerging versions of the Pre- Submission NP had already been informed by the views of local people. However, the residents' comments were very helpful in reinforcing the overall policy framework which was challenged somewhat by some of the statutory consultees (e.g. the importance of the landscape around Dordon.)

To clarify, the specific amendments made to the Pre-Submission draft were a consequence of the comments from the statutory consultees and this is tabulated page 11-page 40 of the Consultation Statement

Question 17 – The Parish Council says that reference should be made to "those areas identified as at risk from surface water and river flooding on Map 9a and 9b". Does this mean Flood Zones 2 and 3 on Map 9a and all the areas shown as affected by flooding from surface water on Map 9b?

Yes this was what was intended.
