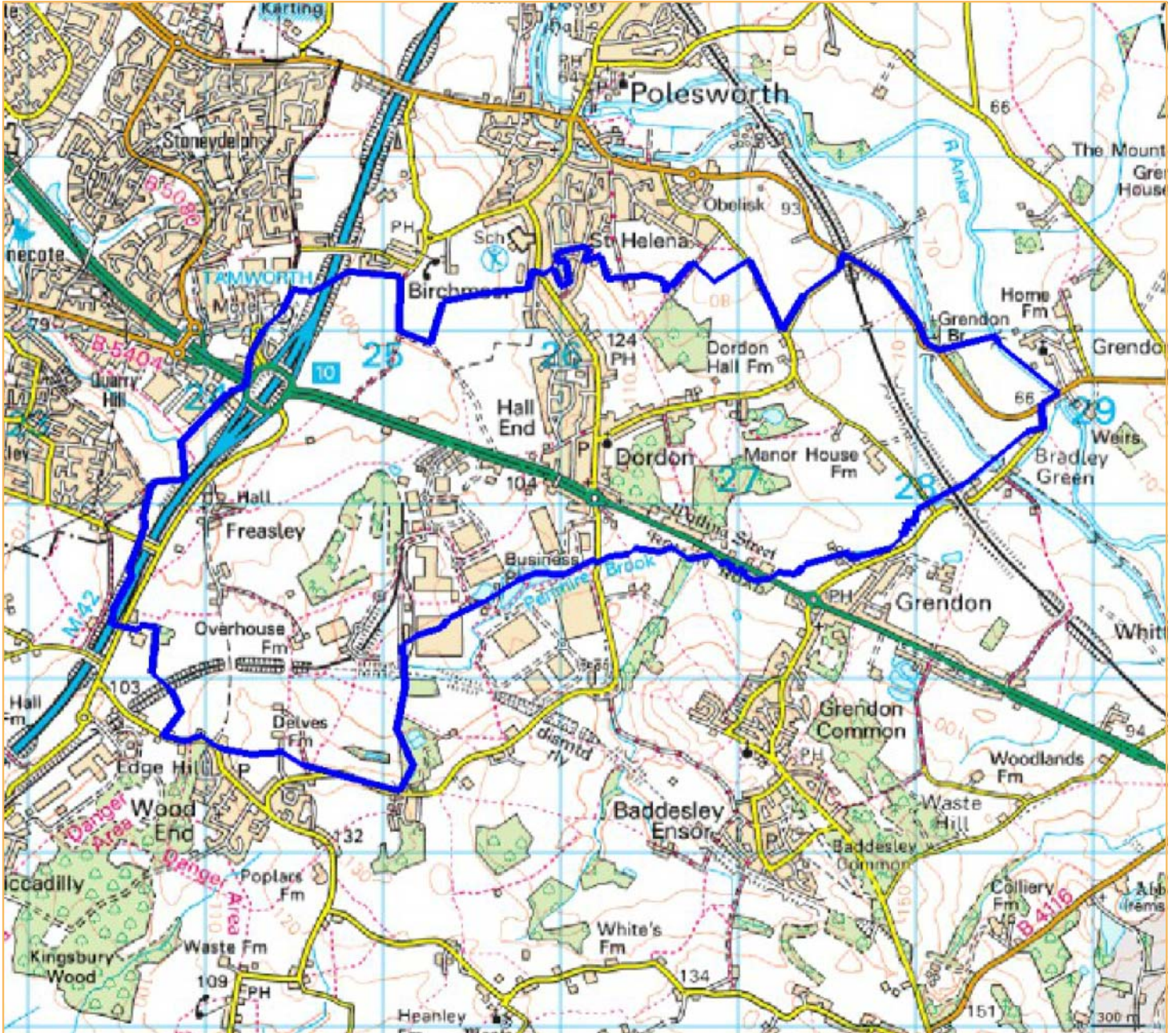

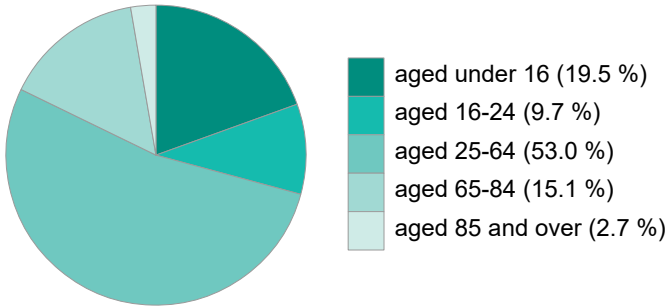

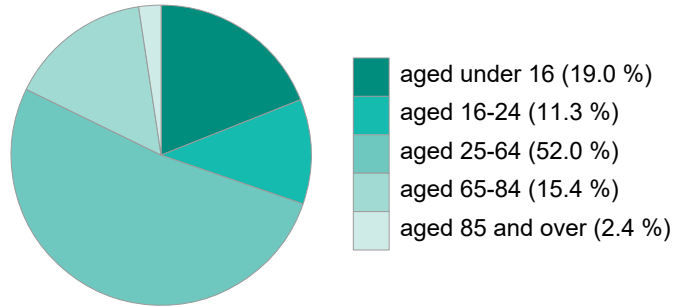

England



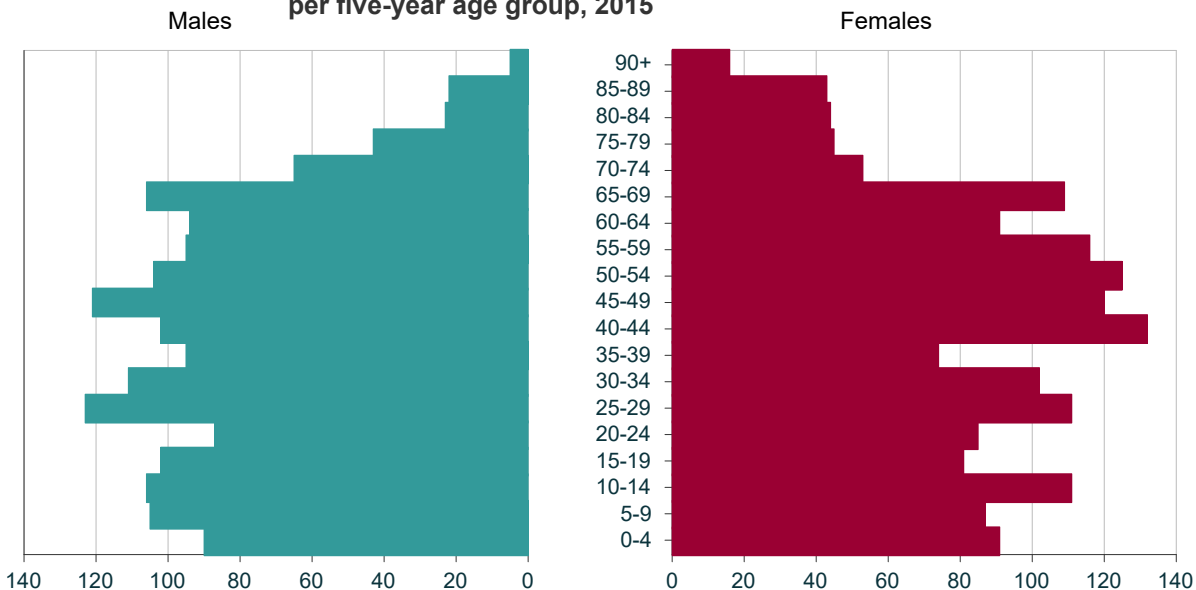

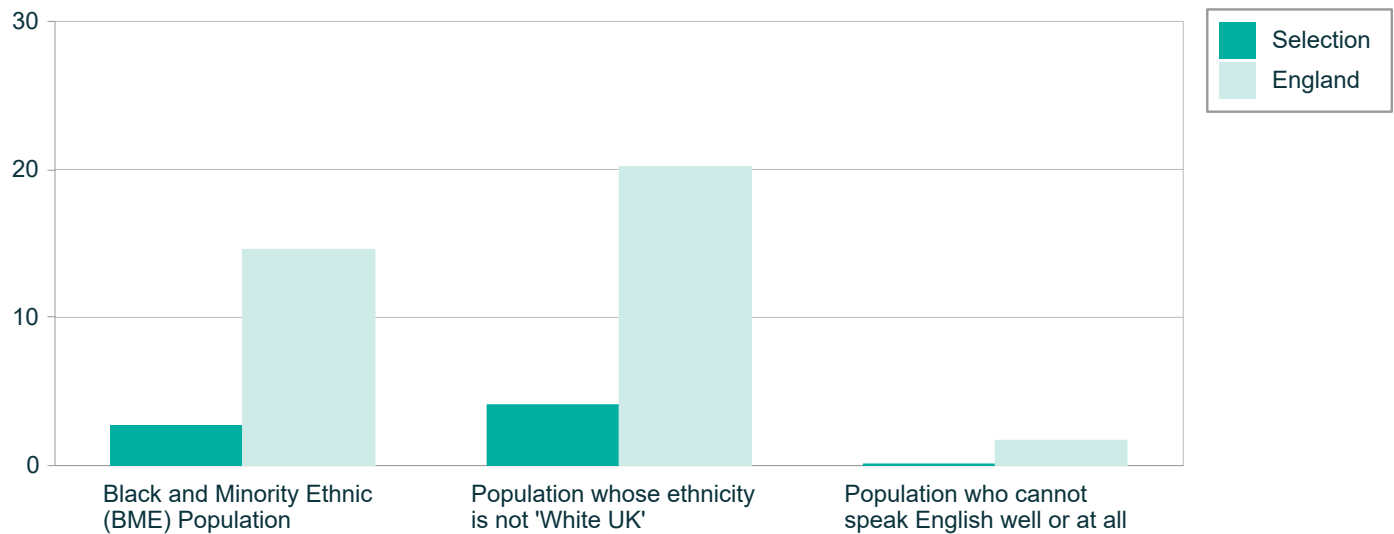

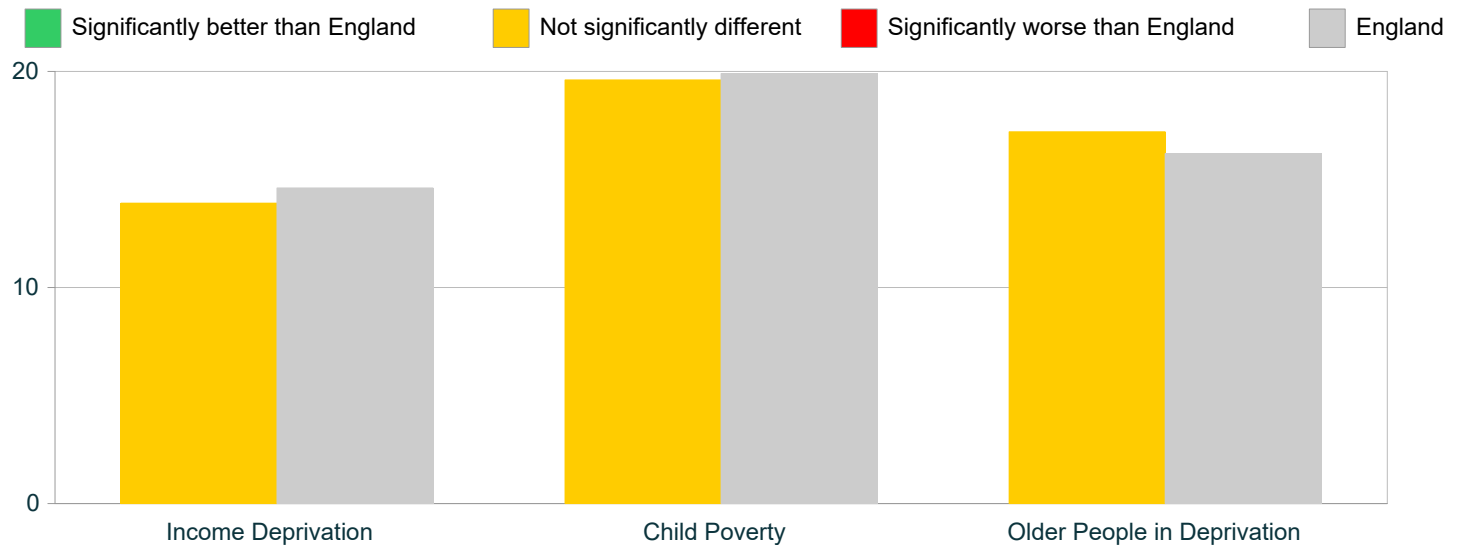

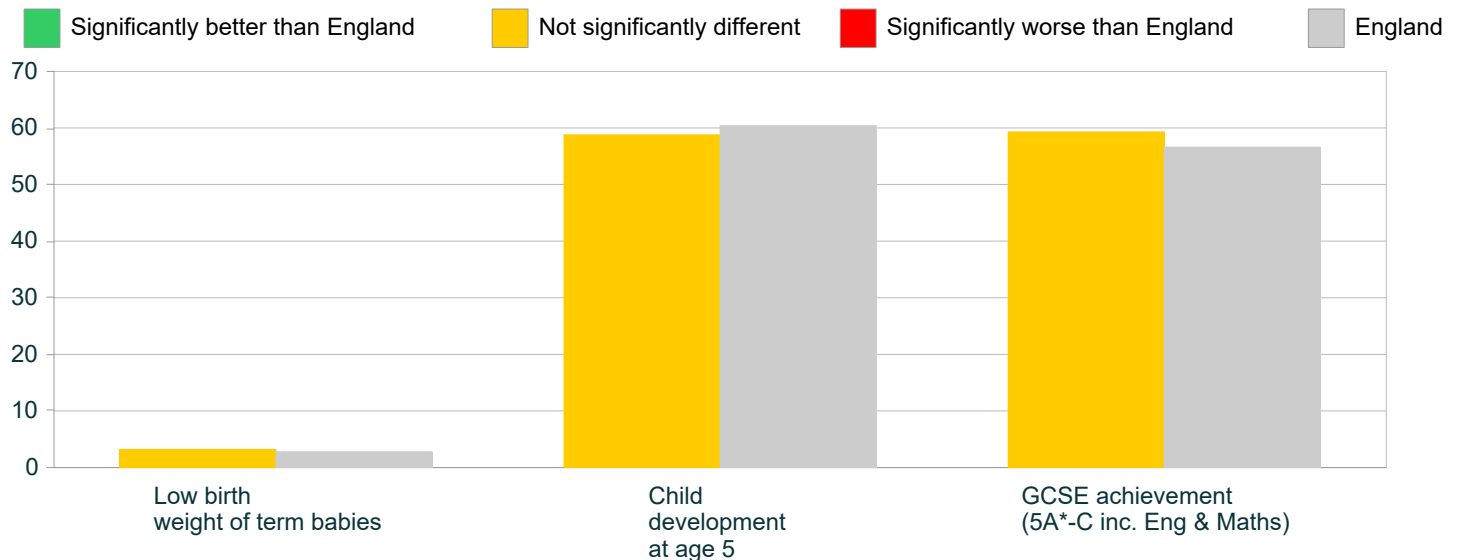

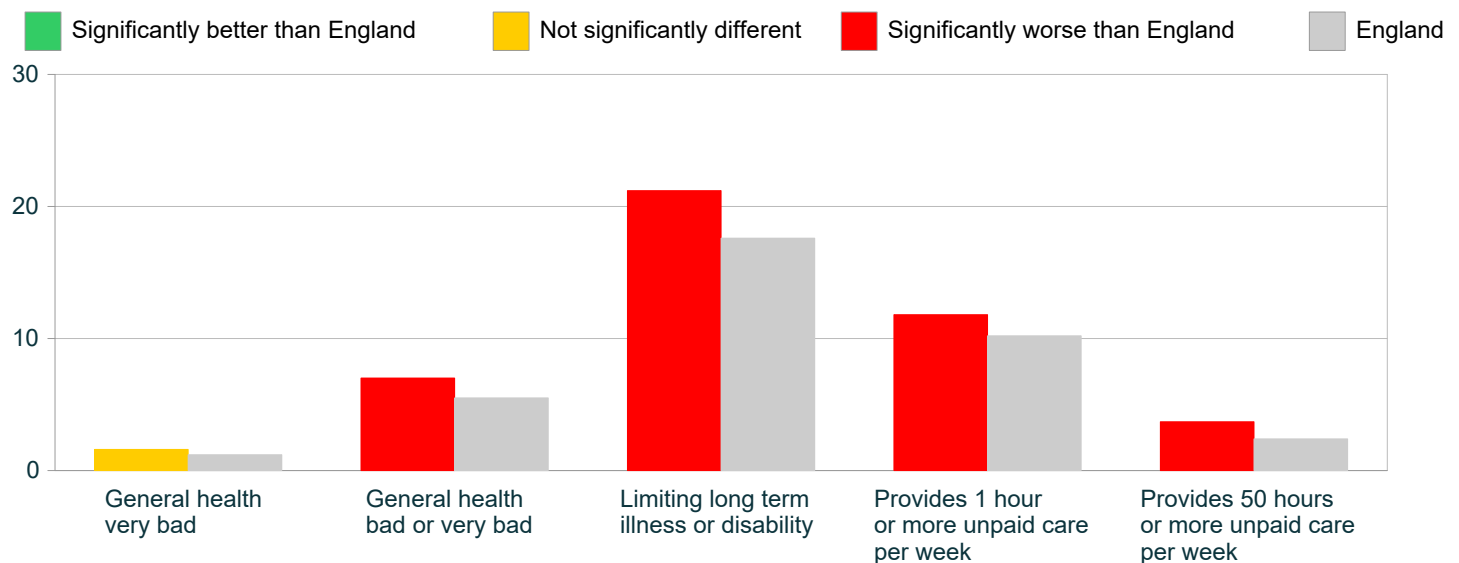

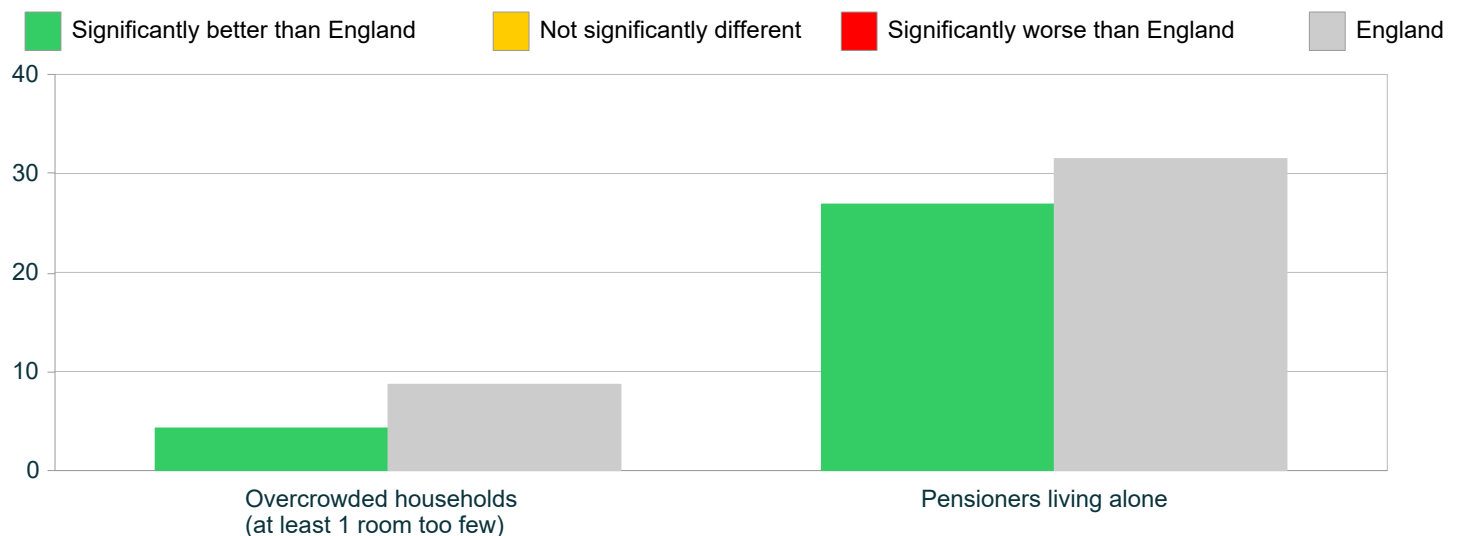

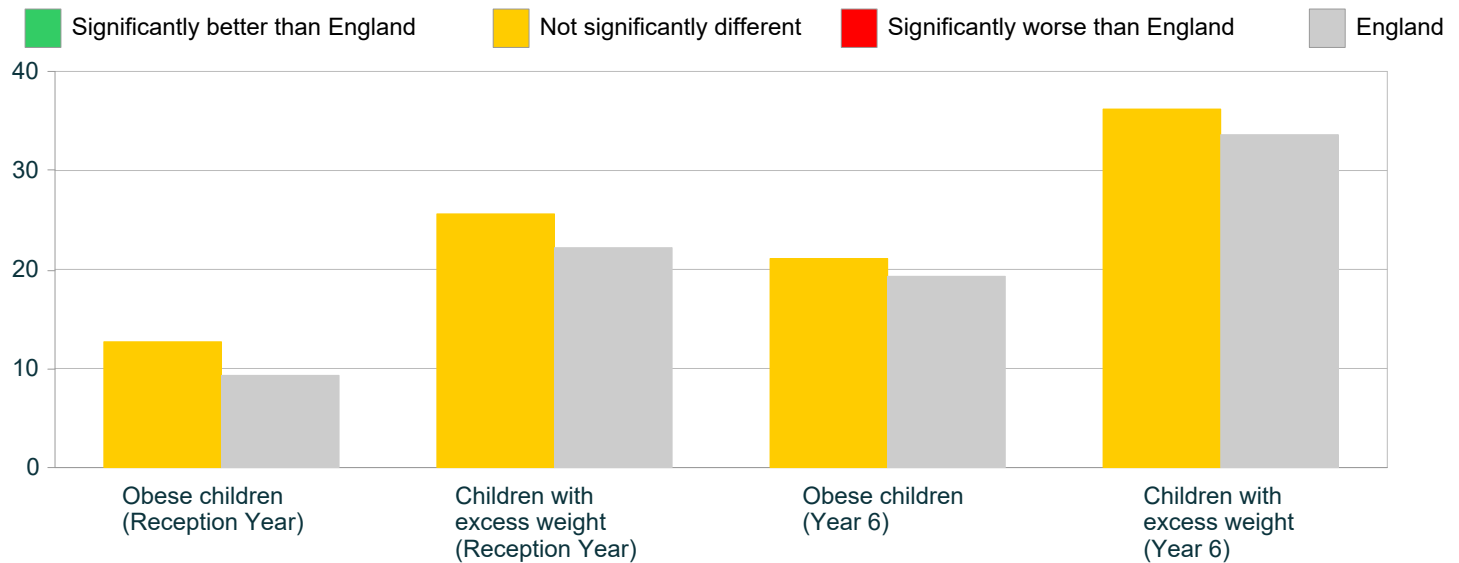

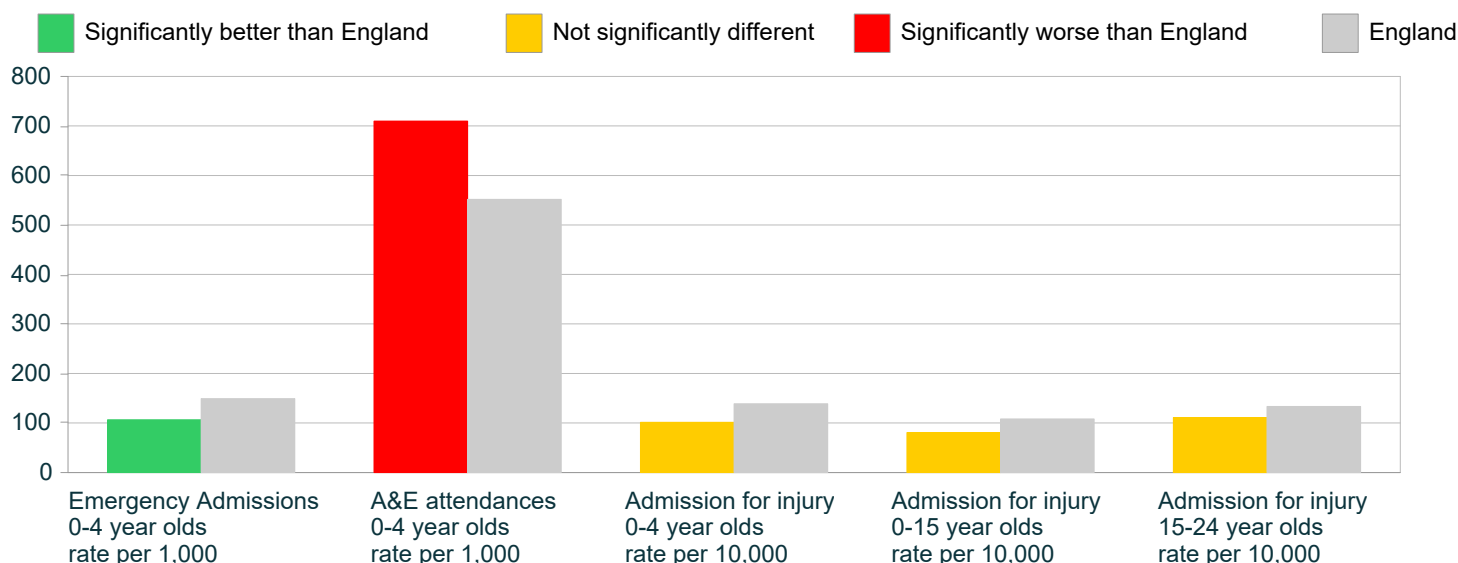

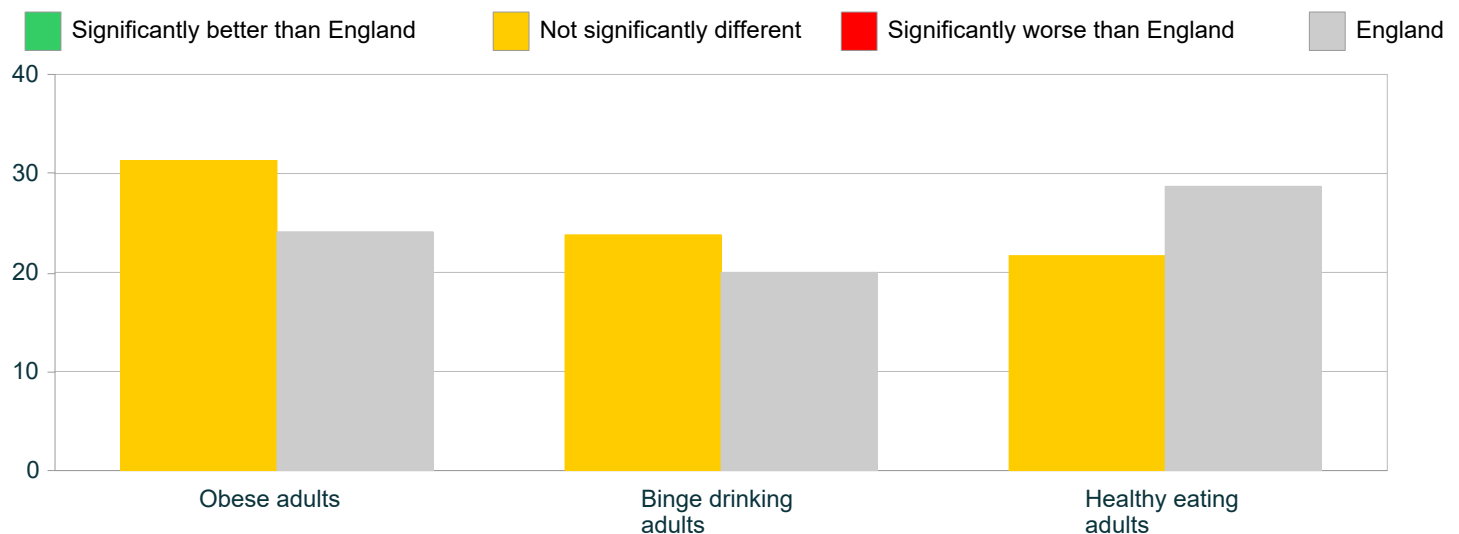

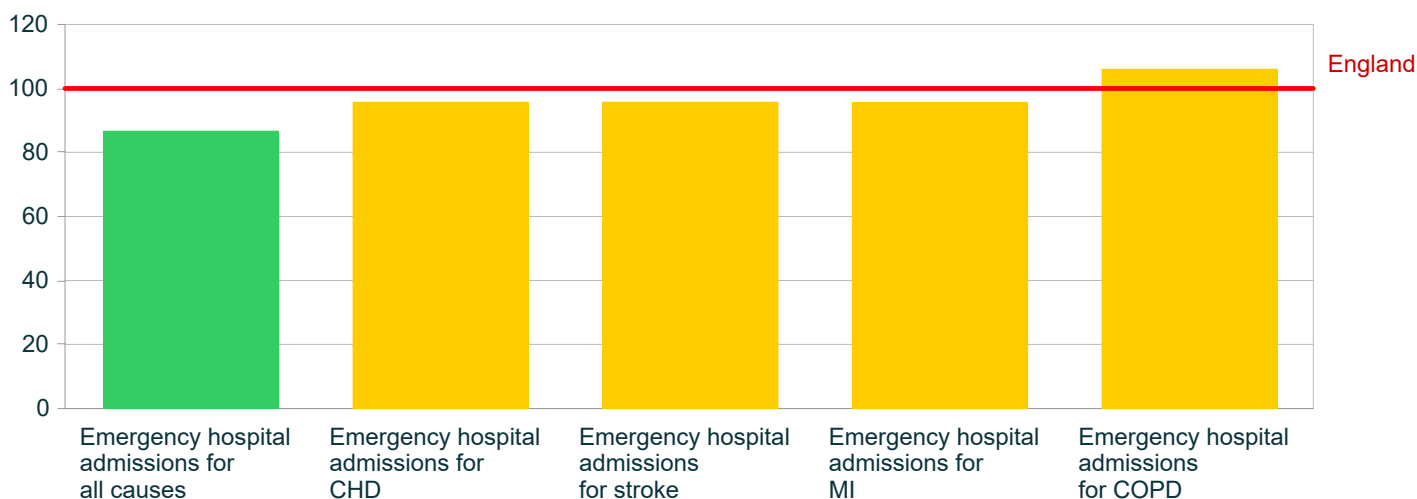

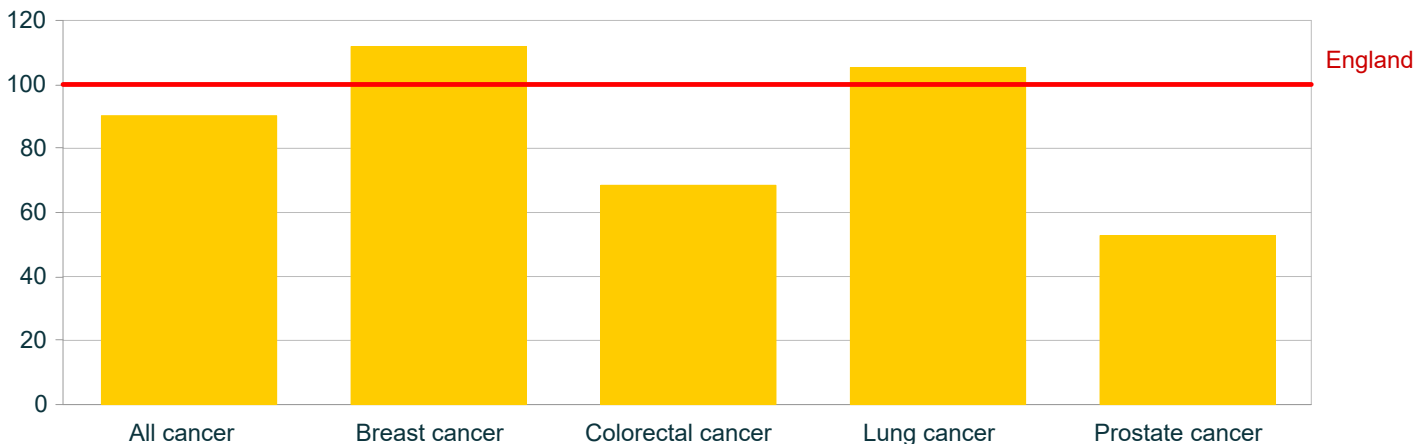

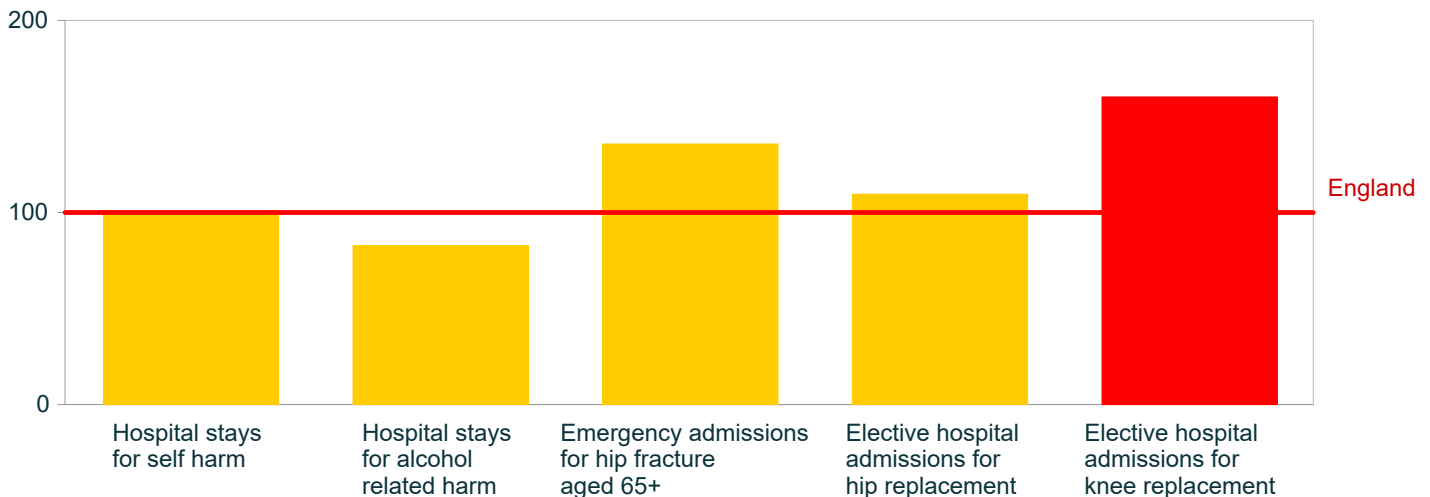

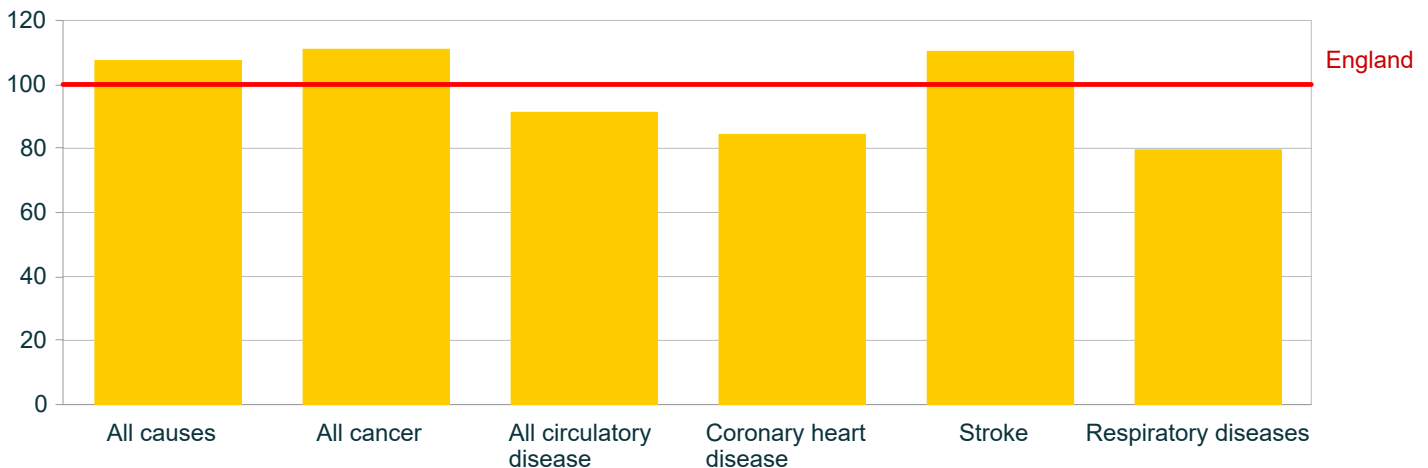

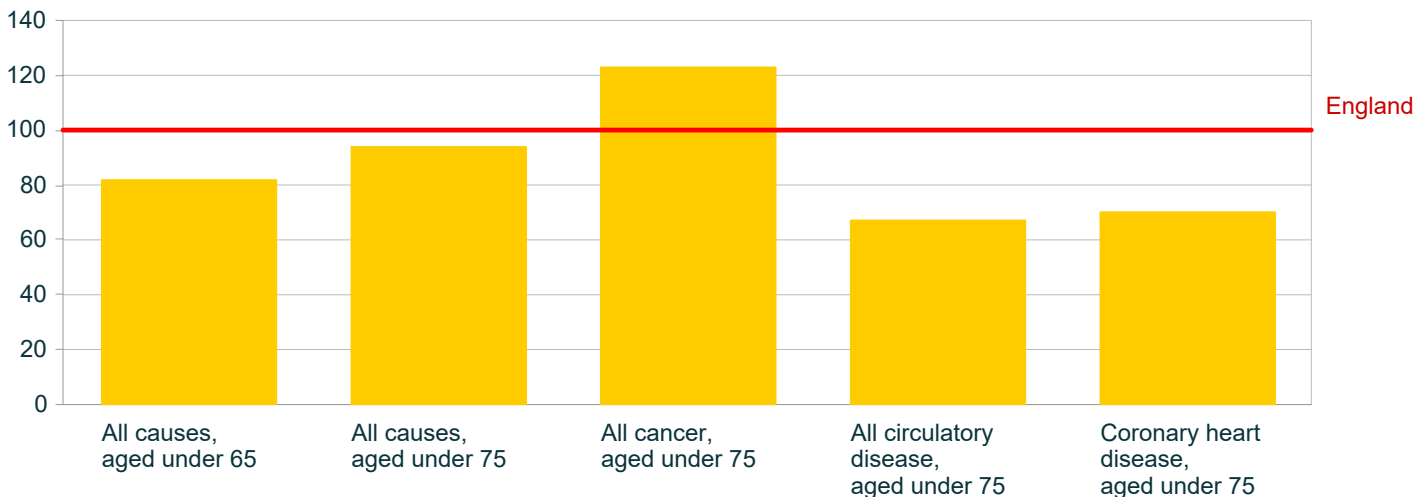

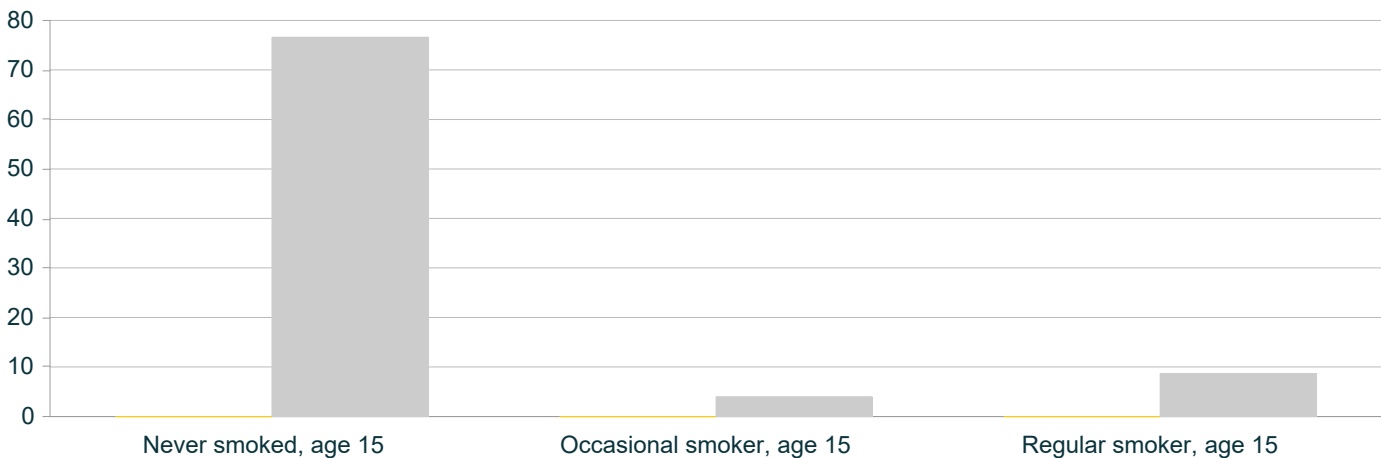

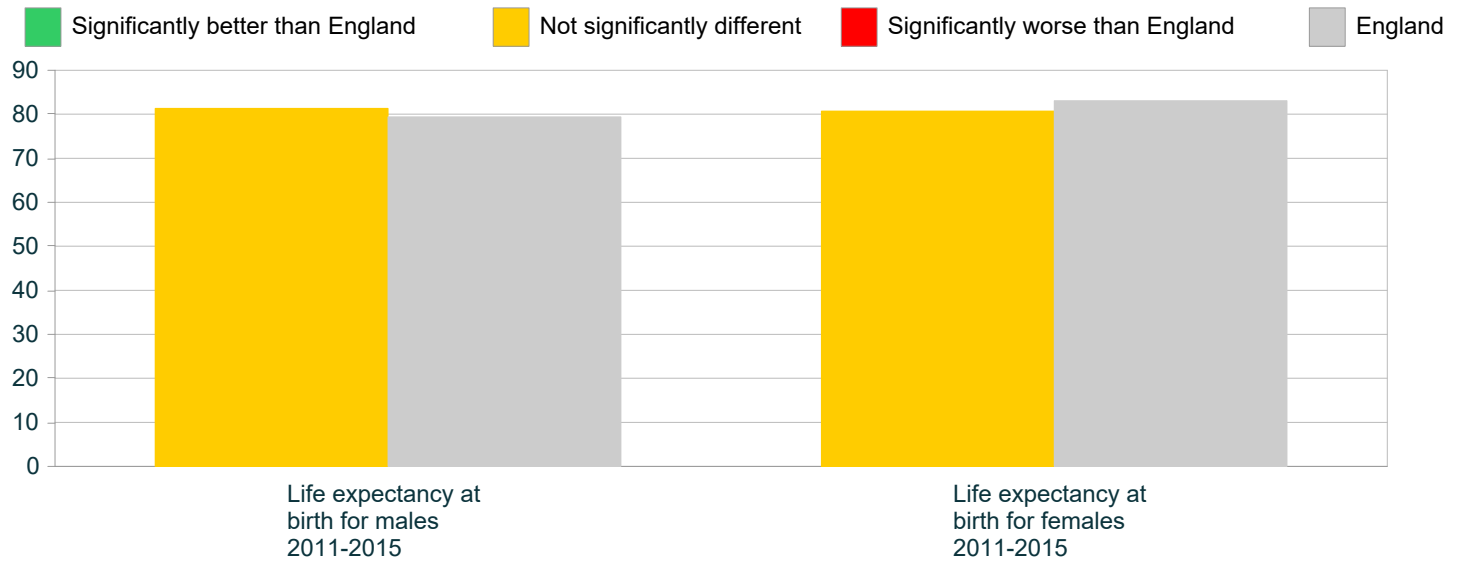
